Isle of Purbeck Best Bitter	Grassy hops aroma with a rich malty, Nutty flavour and finish.	3.6%	9g
Island Brewery Nipper Bitter	Straw coloured, light and refreshing, with a distinguishable balance of malt and hops, and a satisfyingly moreish after-bite. Its character displays the familiar qualities of traditional brewing at its best .	3.8%	9g
