Island Brewery Nipper Bitter	Straw coloured, light and refreshing, with a distinguishable balance of malt and hops, and a satisfyingly moreish after-bite. Its character displays the familiar qualities of traditional brewing at its best.	3.8%	9g
Island Brewery Wight Gold	Crystal malt, golden brown, with rounded malt and hops throughout, creating that characteristic refreshing after-bite of a true craft brew that makes a favourite.	4.0%	9g
Sharps Doom Bar	The aroma of Doom Bar combines an accomplished balance of spicy resinous hop, inviting sweet malt and delicate roasted notes. The mouth feel is a perfectly balanced and complex blend of succulent dried fruit, lightly roasted malty notes and a subtle yet assertive bitterness. The bitterness remains into the finish with dry fruity notes which implore the drinker to go back for more."	4.0%	9g
St Austell Tribute	A Supreme Champion Ale of Cornwall as voted by CAMRA*, and the South West's Favourite cask beer**, Tribute is a popular favourite with locals and visitors to Cornwall, as well as being a much sought after brand throughout the rest of the UK. It is brewed using specially grown Cornish Gold Malt.	4.2%	9g
Island Brewery Yachtsman's Ale	The addition of roasted malt produces a rich brown beer and mouth-feel, counterbalanced by sufficient hops to rise to the nose and to refresh the throat in a subtle complexity of flavours and texture. Mr Grundy's Big Willie	Thirst quenching golden ale packed with English hops giving a light bitter finish.	4.2%	9g
Mr Grundy's No man's land	A medium strength hoppy bitter, dark in colour, retaining the soft, malty flavours of traditional bitter using English hops.	4.5%	9g

Gales HSB	HSB is brewed with the finest malt and hops for a well-balanced character. It is full bodied and silky textured, with a hint of Dundee cake that leads to a rich, fruity taste and a silky-smooth finish. It has an ABV of 4.8% and is a beer to savour.	4.8%	9g
Ringwood Fortyniner	Fortyniner is named after the 1849 gold rush. Golden in colour and brewed to 4.9%, Ringwood has been brewing this classic beer since 1978. Light, fresh hop bouquet. Rounded malt in the mouth with strong hop balance, deep bittersweet finish. Golden full-bodied malted beer.	4.9%	9g
Island Brewery Earl's R.D.A. (Rich Dark Ale)	*Isle of Wight CAMRA Beer of the Year 2014/2015/2016/2017/2018/2019/2020 *World Beer Award Gold 2016 *Silver Medal Winner SIBA South East Beer Festival 2014 A Rich, dark ale (R.D.A). Made with crystal and chocolate malts along with roasted barley. An ale that tastes superb and is extremely moreish with a glorious cappuccino aftertaste. Named after 'Earl' the sunflower emblem of the Earl Mountbatten Hospice. 10p for every pint sold will be donated to the Hospice by the Island Brewery.	5.0%	9g
Mr Grundy's 1914	A Leicester Beer Festival gold medal winner. A dark stout style beer with a hint of blackcurrant. This beer has a balance of dark malts and the hint of sweetness.	5.0%	9g
Fullers ESB	ESB has a wonderful rich mahogany appearance. Taking in the nose, the beer is bursting with cherry and orange, balanced by soft malty toffee and caramel notes. The flavour delivers everything you would expect from such a full-bodied ale. The unique blend of Northdown, Target, Challenger and Goldings hops imparts grassy, peppery notes on the tongue along with intense citrus fruit characters of grapefruits, oranges and lemons. The blend of Pale Ale and Crystal malts in the brew give a biscuity, toffee element to the beer. A smooth, mellow bitterness lingers on the palate to give a superbly satisfying finish.	5.5%	9g
Exmoor Beast	Brewed with a mix of pale ale, chocolate and crystal malts, and hopped with Goldings, Challenger and Brewers Gold, it is dark mahogany-brown in colour, with the merest hint of crimson tints at its edge. Lush rich aromas of toffee, treacle. Mocha coffee, vinous fruit and chocolate swirl above the glass. There's more complexity on the palate with rich fruitcake, a hint of rum, more Mocha coffee, an herbal hoppiness, vinous fruit, while the bittersweet finish is smooth yet complex, rich but not cloying. NOTE: Original recipe used Fuggles hops instead of Brewers Gold.	6.6%	9g
